What do I need to do for the audition?

For the audition, you will need to:

- Choose <u>ONE</u> of the following songs to sing:
 "America" (My Country 'Tis of Thee) or "America the Beautiful".
 You may read from the lyric sheet. The song does not need to be memorized.
- 2. You will sing the "Row, Row, Row Your Boat" in canon with the teacher.
- 3. You will sing a major scale up and down in solfege.
- 4. You will echo short melodies after the teacher.
- 5. You will listen to a chord and sing back the sounds you hear.

Your audition will be recorded for two or more music teachers to hear.

What are you looking for?

We will be listening for your ability to

- sing in tune without help from the piano.
- sing in canon without getting confused.
- listen to the piano and the teacher's voice and sing back what you hear.
- sing with a pure and fluid tone (light "choir" voice, not "solo" voice).
